From 1 September 2024, it is a criminal offence to sell **knives and other controlled items** to minors under 18 in Queensland.

Particular controlled items such as double-edged knives, axes, machetes, sickles, swords and spears, are also required by law to be securely stored prior to sale.

The law applies to all persons, businesses and places, which sell impacted items into or within Queensland. Penalties may apply.
